Matter has come up on an application (IA No.1/2026) filed by and on behalf of applicant- Shri Ravindra Singh Rathore, seeking his impleadment in the present writ petition as party respondent, pointing out that petitioners are encroachers and have concealed several documents from this Hon'ble Court.
2. Petitioners, in the writ petition, have assailed the notice and proceedings initiated by the Tehsildar for eviction under Section 91 of the Land Revenue Act.
3. Considering the scope of writ jurisdiction and the averments made by the applicant in the application, this Court deems it just and proper to extend opportunity of hearing to the applicant as well.
4. Accordingly, the application (IA No.1/2026) is allowed. Applicant- Shri Ravindra Singh Rathore is permitted to be impleaded as party respondent No.7 in the present writ petition. Amended cause title, enclosed with the application, is taken on record and same be placed at appropriate place.

5. Counsel for petitioners is directed to serve copy of writ petition in the office of learned counsel, appearing for newly impleaded respondent.
6. Counsel for newly impleaded respondent is directed to file reply to the writ petition within a period of two weeks.
7. Interim order shall continue.
