**Order**

**25/02/2026**

1. The FIR No.483/2022 came to be lodged at the instance of one Bhawani Shankar Vyas in relation to some allegations having connection with a Plot No.46 A issued by the Municipal Council, Sridungargarh. The matter was investigated thoroughly and finally a closure report got submitted in the matter and the same is pending in the Court of ACJM, Sridungargarh upon making protest by the complainant. Now strangely without there being any substance, the Additional SP ACB Bikaner outpost issued a notice Annexure 2 (dated 10.02.2026) to appear before him and to show the Patta pertaining to Plot No.46 A which has been the subject matter of the FIR referred above.

2. There appears reasonable ground to interfere in the matter.

3. Issue notice.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, thus, notice need not be issued. He seeks some time to file reply.
5. List the matter after four weeks.
6. Prima facie, the petitioner has a strong arguable case in his favour, thus, the stay petition is disposed of and it is ordered that till disposal of the writ petition, further proceeding initiated at the of ACB Bureau including notice dated 10.02.2026 shall remain stayed.
