Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a suit for permanent injunction was instituted against the Sarpanch and the Secretary Gram Panchayat, Sindu. During the pendency of the said suit, the notice so issued was put to challenge.

It is further submitted that an application under Order I Rule 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 came to be filed by certain

persons claiming to be affected parties/interested parties, seeking their impleadment as party respondents in the suit. Notices were issued on the said application, and the learned Trial Court, after due consideration, allowed the application and passed an interim order, thereby impleading them as party respondents in the proceedings.

The matter requires consideration.

Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks.

In the meantime and till next date, the impugned order dated 07.02.2026, passed by learned Civil Judge, Mawli, District Udaipur in Civil Suit No.79/2024 shall remain stayed.
