1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. Perused contents of the petition alongwith annexures thereof.

3. Pledged case is that both petitioners are major and it is their first marriage. Both are adult, wife 22 years old and husband 28 years old and thus fully capable and legally competent to take decision to choose their life partners.

4. In the premise, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Deedwana-Kuchaman; Station House Officer, PS Ladnu, District Deedwana-Kuchaman and Station House Officer, PS Badi Khatu, District Deedwana-Kuchaman that the contents of the representation to be filed by the petitioners seeking protection of life and liberty be duly verified. If warranted, requisite steps be taken, in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is clarified that this order shall neither be treated as a stamp of this Court *qua* marriage of the petitioners nor any reflection on the merits of the contentions raised by them in the present petition.

5. Present petition stands disposed of.
