1. Heard on interim stay application.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are working on the post of Block Coordinator/Accountant which is under the Scheme sponsored by the Central Government.
3. By the impugned order, the respondents tried to replace the petitioners by way of a fresh contractual employees, even though, their contract period has already been extended till upto 31st March, 2026.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that one set of contractual employee cannot be replaced by another set of employee, even though, they are working through an Outsourcing Agency. Even if the Outsourcing Agency is changed, the services of the petitioners cannot be replaced by any other set of employees sponsored by fresh Outsourcing Agency.
5. In the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court finds appropriate to direct the respondents not to replace the petitioners by any other set of employees of similar nature.
6. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable in four weeks.
7. List the matter on 23.04.2026.
