1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted permission to travel abroad with effect from 05.03.2026 vide order dated 12.12.2025. It is further contended that such permission was necessitated on account of the pendency of a criminal case against the petitioner. It is submitted that the said criminal case has since been finally decided and the petitioner stands acquitted.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, accordingly, prays that the impugned order, whereby only limited permission has been granted, be quashed and set aside and the Passport Authority may be directed to renew the passport of the petitioner in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent No.2 does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has been acquitted and submits that the case of the petitioner shall be considered in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above and considering the fact that the petitioner has been acquitted, the present writ petition is allowed. The impugned order dated 12.12.2025 (Annexure-2) is hereby quashed and set aside. The Passport Authority is directed to consider and decide the application of the petitioner for renewal of passport strictly in accordance with law.

5. Needless to observe that if the petitioner intends to travel abroad prior to the period from 05.03.2026 to 15.03.2026, the impugned order shall not come in his way, provided he is otherwise eligible to travel abroad in accordance with law.
