1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, by way of impugned orders dated 02.12.2025, 19.11.2025, 22.01.2026,

15.01.2026, 20.11.2025 and 26.11.2025, respondents have directed recovery of House Rent Allowance (HRA) and City Compensatory Allowance (CCA) paid to petitioner, alleging that the same were paid in excess. It is urged by learned counsel that petitioner has neither made any misrepresentation nor committed any fraud; therefore, impugned orders directing recovery are arbitrary and unjust.

2. Matter requires consideration.

3. Issue notice to respondents. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of four weeks.

4. In the meanwhile and until the next date, no recovery shall be effected from the petitioner in pursuance of impugned orders dated 02.12.2025 (Annex. 1), 19.11.2025, 22.01.2026, 15.01.2026, 20.11.2025 and 26.11.2025 (Annex. 7 to 11).
