1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an order dated 30.05.2024 was passed by the Tehsildar, Barmer upon an application filed by the petitioner under Section 183B of the Rajasthan Tenancy Act, 1955 and directions were issued to remove the encroachment upon the land of the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel also submits that against the said order, an appeal was filed before the District Collector, Barmer in the month of June, 2024 by respondent No.7 and respondent No.8 has also filed an appeal, which are still pending consideration.
3. Learned counsel on the one hand submits that appeals so filed by the private respondents have not been decided yet and on the other hand submits that the order dated 30.05.2024 for removal of encroachment upon the land of petitioner has also not been implemented.
4. Learned counsel seeks limited indulgence of this Court in issuing direction to the District Collector, Barmer to decide pending appeals No.27/2024 and No.28/2024 in a time bound manner.
5. In view of the above, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the District Collector, Barmer to decide pending appeals No.27/2024 and No.28/2024 within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of this order, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order after granting opportunity of hearing to the parties.
6. With these observations, the writ petition is **disposed of**.

7. Stay application and all pending application(s) are also
disposed of.
