HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE SANJEET PUROHIT**Order****29/04/2026**

1. The issue involved in the present case is relating to rejection of ad-interim relief prayed by the petitioners by the learned Additional Divisional Commissioner, Jodhpur, in Revenue Appeal No.416/2024 vide its order dated 06.12.2024.
2. Revision petition has been filed against the said order, which has also been dismissed by holding the same to be not maintainable against an order of interlocutory nature.
3. Looking to the controversy involved in the present case that the same relates to not passing of ad-interim relief, where the main appeal itself is pending consideration, this Court is of the considered opinion that instead of passing any order on merits of the case at this stage, it would be appropriate to direct the learned Additional Divisional Commissioner, Jodhpur to decide the Appeal No.416/2024 in expeditious manner.
4. Learned counsel for the parties do not oppose the same.
5. In view thereof, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Additional Divisional Commissioner, Jodhpur to decide the pending Revenue Appeal No.416/2024 expeditiously, preferably within a period of 30 days from the date

of receipt of certified copy of this order, without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties.

6. It is made clear that this order shall not construed as directing learned Additional Divisional Commissioner, Jodhpur to decide the appeal of petitioner in any particular manner, but only in accordance with law.

7. With these observations, present writ petition is **disposed of**.

8. Stay petition and all pending applications, if any, are hereby disposed of.
