1. Heard learned counsel for the appellant on the application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act seeking condonation of delay of 26 days in filing the criminal appeal under Section 372 Cr.P.C. (Section 419 BNSS) against the judgment dated 02.12.2024 passed by the learned Special Judge (Women Atrocities Cases), Sri Ganganagar in Criminal Case No. 67/2016, whereby the respondent-accused has been acquitted of the offences under Sections 354A(2), 354D, 506 and 306 IPC.

2. For the reasons stated in the application and upon due consideration of the explanation furnished therein, this Court is satisfied that sufficient cause has been shown for not preferring the appeal within the prescribed period of limitation.

3. Accordingly, the application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act is allowed. The delay of 26 days in filing the appeal stands condoned.
4. The appeal is treated as filed within limitation.
