HON'BLE DR. JUSTICE PUSHPENDRA SINGH BHATI**Order****19/04/2022**

In wake of instant surge in COVID-19 cases and spread of its highly infectious Omicron variant, abundant caution is being maintained, while hearing the matters in Court, for the safety of all concerned.

Learned counsel for the appellants has shown the FIR lodged by the appellants, in which, the same complainant has been found to be have made the trespass upon the plot of the present appellants. Learned counsel further submits that the charge-sheet under Section 448 IPC has been filed.

Learned counsel also submits that there are neither any injuries nor the statement of the mother of the complainant

constitute the offence in question. Learned counsel further submits that the police has filed the closure report.

Issue notice to the respondent No.2 only, as the learned Public Prosecutor already appearing on behalf of respondent No.1-State, returnable within four weeks.

In the meanwhile, further proceedings in Criminal Original Sessions Case No.116/2021 (State Vs. Chandraprakash & Anr.) pending before learned Special Judge, SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, Jalore shall remain stayed.
