1. Ms. Abhilasha Bora, learned counsel for the appellant submits that vide order dated 17.02.2025, passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 3942/2025, the learned Single Bench of this Court imposed a condition of depositing 50% of the amount.
2. Ms. Bora has shown the order dated 30.01.2025, passed by a Single Bench of this Court in ***S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 2529/2025 (Surendra Hindu Singh Bhati & Anr. Vs. Chairman District Consumer Disputes Redressal***

Commission & Anr.) on the similar issue wherein, the stay order was passed without any condition of pre-deposit.

3. She further submits that while passing the aforesaid stay order, the condition of 50 per cent deposition of the liability has been imposed by the learned Single Bench. She has raised the issue of parity.

4. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within period of four weeks.

5. In the meanwhile, while the interim order dated already passed by the learned Single Bench shall remain in currency, the condition to deposit 50 per cent amount shall remain stayed.
