After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and upon perusal of the prayer clause in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.

17670/2025, this Court *prima facie* finds that the relief claimed in the present writ petition is identical to that sought in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.17670/2025.

Subsequent to the filing of the aforesaid writ petition, the respondents have passed an order dated 16.01.2026 (Annexure-P/13), whereby issuance of a No Objection Certificate (NOC) in favour of the petitioner has been declined on the ground that the issue regarding non-issuance of the NOC is already the subject matter of S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.17670/2025.

In the opinion of this Court, the order dated 16.01.2026 is fully justified, and no fresh cause of action has arisen in favour of the petitioner for filing the present writ petition during the pendency of S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.17670/2025.

Faced with the aforesaid situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file an appropriate application in the pending writ petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for.

The stay petition also stands disposed of.
