1. Heard on the Misc. Interim Stay Application.
2. The limited grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner was initially convicted for the offence under Sections 332, 353, 323 and 504 of IPC and sentenced to undergo six months simple imprisonment and fine of Rs.7,000/-. Against the said conviction and sentence, he preferred an appeal, where the conviction is maintained and probation was extended of the petitioner while the petitioner was directed to pay an amount of Rs.7,000/- for prosecution expenses. In the interim directions, he wants to stay on the said amount.
3. Looking to the facts on which the present revision petition has been filed and taking the facts into consideration, prima facie, this Court feels that the petitioner, who is employed as

a Guard and whose duty was disturbed, there shall be stay on the order dated 29.01.2026 in Criminal Appeal No. 44/2023 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge No.2 Hanumangarh to the extent of depositing the amount of Rs.7,000/- for probation expenses.

4. Admit.
5. Issue notice to the respondent No.2, returnable in eight weeks.
6. Call for record.
7. List the matter on 29.06.2026.
