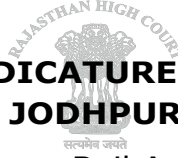

1. The instant bail application has been filed by the applicant **Kishnaram S/o Bhuraram** under Section 483 BNSS against the order impugned passed by learned court below in connection with **FIR No.46/2026** registered at **Police Station Raipur District Beawar (Old District Pali)** for the offence(s) under **Section 8/18 of NDPS Act.**

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the case. He submits that the matter relates to recovery of Opium plants where Section 18C of NDPS Act applies. Learned counsel further submits that previously there is no case under the NDPS Act registered against the applicant. He further submits that the applicant is behind the bars and trial may take long time to conclude thus, he deserves to be enlarged on bail.



3. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

4. Considering the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, and looking to the overall facts and circumstances of the case, keeping in view the provisions of Section 18C of NDPS Act, without commenting on the merits and demerits of the case, this court deems it just and proper to enlarge the applicant on bail.

5. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-applicant shall be enlarged on bail in the aforesaid FIR provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned Lower Court for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
