1. By way of the instant criminal misc. petition, a challenge has been made to the order dated 05.09.2025 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sanchoe, District Jalore, whereby the application of the petitioner for providing copy of the complete Final Report has been returned with a direction to the petitioner to file application through the Assistant Public Prosecutor, as it being a State case.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the judgment passed by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Bhagwant Singh Vs. Commissioner of Police, Delhi reported in 1985 AIR 1285** as well as of Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **Naeem Khan Goran Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.,** (S.B. Criminal Misc. Petition No.8416/2024, decided on 17.12.2024).

3. This Court has heard learned counsel for the parties and has perused the material available on record.
4. Hon'ble Apex Court in **Bhagwant Singh (supra)** has clearly held that the informant who has set the machinery of investigation into motion by filing FIR must know about the result of investigation initiated on the basis of FIR and the report forwarded to Magistrate under Section 21 of Section 173 Cr. P.C. should also be supplied to him. Similarly, Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in Naeem Khan Goran (supra) has also allowed prayer of the complainant and directed learned trial court to supply copy of Final Report alongwith all relevant documents.
5. In view of the same, this Court is inclined to allow the present misc. petition.
6. The learned trial court has erred in returning the application of petitioner seeking copy of Final Report and asking him to file the same through the Assistant Public Prosecutor as his right to get the copy is not dependent upon the State or the Assistant Public Prosecutor and he has an independent right.
7. In view of the same, the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sanchore is directed to supply Final Report alongwith all the relevant papers to the petitioner/complainant forthwith.
8. Stay application and all pending applications, if any, stands disposed of accordingly.
