1. The matter has come up for admission.
2. Advance copies have been served upon Mr. Mukesh Rajpurohit, learned Deputy Solicitor General, learned counsel for respondent No.1, Mr. Akshay Nagori, learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3, Mr. N.S. Rajpurohit, learned counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 and Mr. Manish Patel, learned Additional Advocate General for respondent No.6.
3. Issue notice.
4. Service of notice upon all the aforesaid respondents stands complete.
5. There is no need to issue notice to respondent No.7 at this stage.

6. Though, Mr. M.S. Singvi, learned Senior counsel has harped upon an interim protection but a statement is made by Mr. Akshay Nagori, learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 that University Grants Commission itself is contemplating a part of the impugned order to be challenged.
7. Mr. Akshay Nagori and Mr. Manish Patel, learned Additional Advocate General submit that they will update their instructions.
8. Mr. Akshay Nagori shall be required to file an additional affidavit. Copy of the same be supplied to the learned counsel for the appellant atleast three days before the next date.
9. This Court is aware of the agony faced by the students, but does not wish to delve into the matter by passing any interim order at this stage, as the pleadings are almost complete because it is a Special Appeal Writ matter and, therefore, the matter be listed on 06.05.2024 with an understanding that the parties shall make endeavor to get the matter finally decided.
10. In case, there are certain discrepancies in the pagination of the file, the office shall remove the same. In case a fresh set or any kind of help is required from the appellant side, the learned counsel for the appellant shall provide the same.
