1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide earlier
order dated 18.11.2025, petitioner was transferred from Sub
Helath Centre, Bibipur (PHC Dabri) Block Bhadra, District
Hanumangarh to Community Health Centre, Tibbi, Block Tibbi,

District Hanumangarh on a 'working arrangement' basis. The said order was stayed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 21.01.2026 in S.B.C.W.P. No.24346/2025, while making a prima facie observation that such an order, being without jurisdiction and amounting to a transfer, cannot be passed under the guise of a working arrangement.

2. In view of the fact that the earlier transfer order issued on a working arrangement basis was stayed, the respondents have again issued the impugned transfer dated 23.03.2026 directing the petitioner to report to Primary Health Centre, Tibbi, again on a working arrangement.

3. Matter requires consideration.

4. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.

5. In the meantime, effect and operation of order dated 23.02.2026 (Annexure-11) & reliving order dated 24.02.2026 (Annexure-12) shall remain stayed qua the petitioner.
