HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE SUNIL BENIWAL

Order

1. The petitioners have preferred the present criminal misc. petition being aggrieved by lodging of the FIR No.49/2021 registered at Police Station Ramgarh, District Jaisalmer for the offences under Sections 420, 467, 468 & 471 of the IPC.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that FIR in question was lodged in the year 2021. The principle allegation in the present FIR is with regard to obtaining loan on the basis of some forged documents, however, learned counsel submits that the loan so obtained has already been repaid and as on date, there is nothing due. Moreover, petitioners have not been named in the FIR despite which they are being harassed.
3. In compliance of order dated 15.04.2026, learned Public Prosecutor has submitted detailed factual report dated 07.05.2026 wherein it is indicated that petitioners have obtained loan based on some forged documents and investigation so far clearly indicates *prima facie* involvement of the present petitioners in the crime in question. The factual report dated 07.05.2026 is taken on record.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at this stage, submits that petitioners obtained loan on a land, which is owned by them and have also shown this Court certain Jamabandis indicating that the land was in their names and loan was obtained in accordance

with law. He further submits that petitioners may be permitted to appear before the Investigating Officer, so as to submit all the original documents and satisfy with regard to the genuineness of the same.

5. Considering the submissions made above, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present criminal misc. petition while granting liberty to the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer with a representation alongwith all the documents pertaining to the ownership of the land in question so also other documents for obtaining loan.

6. If any such representation is submitted within a period of one week from today, the Investigating Officer shall consider the same so also the documents before taking final decision.

7. As an interim protection, it is directed that petitioners, shall not be arrested till 18.05.2026.

8. With these observations, the present criminal misc. petition stands disposed of.

9. Pending application(s), if any, stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
