1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 15.01.2025, petitioner was transferred from the post of BCMO, Kushalgarh, Banswara to CHC, Sabla, District Dungarpur. Challenging the same, the petitioner filed an appeal before the Rajasthan Civil Services Appellate Tribunal (hereinafter referred to as "RAT"), which vide order dated 20.02.2025, stayed effect and operation of the transfer order and considering the health condition of petitioner, directed the respondents authorities to decide the representation of petitioner by a speaking order.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after a lapse of one year, respondent rejected the representation of petitioner by a completely non speaking and unseasoned order dated 20.02.2026 and immediately relieved the petitioner on 24.02.2026. The said rejection order was challenged by the petitioner, however, learned Tribunal has dismissed the appeal vide judgment dated 10.02.2026. Learned counsel for petitioner places relies upon order dated 19.10.2023 passed a Coordinate Bench at Jaipur in S.B.C.W.P. No. 17142/2023.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner states that the learned Tribunal failed to consider that, in the earlier round of litigation, specific directions were issued to decide the representation by a speaking order while duly considering the contentions raised by the petitioner. However, impugned order dated 20.02.2026 is completely silent with regard to the avermetns made in the petitioner's representation.

4. Matter requires consideration.

5. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.

6. In the meantime, effect and operation of order dated 20.02.2026 and relieving order dated 24.02.2026 shall remain stayed.

7. The respondents are directed to permit the petitioner to discharge his duties on his earlier place of posting.
