1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier
notification dated 03.06.2025 issued by State Government for

creating a new village "Adarshpur" has already been quashed by Co-ordinate bench of this Court vide order dated 16.07.2025 passed in S.B. C.W.P. No. 12364/2025; however, it was kept open that in case, creation of revenue village is necessary, then the same shall be created in any other name than "*Shri Chamunda Nagar or Adarshpur*".

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that despite quashing of said notification dated 03.06.2025, District Collector, Jodhpur, vide order dated 06.02.2026, while deciding the representation, has declared a new revenue village in the name of Adarshpur.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that impugned order dated 06.02.2026 is not only in violation of judgment passed by this Court, but is also absolutely without jurisdiction, as the declaration of new village can only be done by way of notification to be issued by State Government.

4. Matter requires consideration.

5. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.

6. In the meantime, effect and operation of impugned order dated 06.02.2026 shall remain stayed.
