1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with regard to dispute concerning the alleged encroachment made by the respondents upon the land of petitioners, four inspection reports dated 01.05.2025 (Annex.4), 20.06.2025 (Annex.5), 13.11.2025

(Annex.6) and a report by the Settlement Team of the Revenue Department dated 18.12.2026 (Annex.10) have already been prepared under the orders of Tehsildar, Sirohi/ District Collector, Sirohi, which clearly record the encroachment by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that a revenue suit is already pending consideration before the Court of SDO, Sirohi and that, merely to create evidence in their favour, the private respondents have moved a representation to respondent No. 1, pursuant to which the directions under the impugned order have been issued for conducting a fifth inspection report. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that there was no justification for passing the order of undertaking fresh survey inspite of several inspections / survey reports being already available on record.

2. Matter requites consideration.
3. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.
4. In the meantime, further proceedings in pursuance of orders dated 04.03.2026 and 13.03.2026 shall remain stayed.
