1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-petitioner. The petitioner has been arrested in connection with FIR No.34/2026 registered at Police Station Desuri, District Pali for the offence(s) under Sections 8, 15 & 18 of NDPS Act.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the alleged quantity of poppy straw and opium milk recovered from the possession of the petitioner is 18.140 Kg. and 1.230 Kg. respectively, which is below commercial quantity. There are no criminal antecedents against the petitioner, the accused-petitioner is in custody since long and the trial/investigation of the case may take considerable time, therefore, the bail application may be allowed.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the bail application.
4. Heard and perused the material available on record.
5. Considering the fact that the alleged recovered quantity of poppy straw and opium milk recovered from the possession of the petitioner is below commercial quantity and petitioner is not having criminal antecedents. The trial/investigation of the case may take considerable time, therefore, without expressing anything on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.
6. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Mani Ram S/o Sohanram**, in connection with FIR No.34/2026 registered at Police Station Desuri, District Pali shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
