1. Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset submits that the controversy involved in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the judgment passed by this Court in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.6979/2025 (***Dr. Sandeep Prajapat & Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.***) and other connected matters, decided by a common order dated 21.05.2025.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners prays that the present writ petition may also be disposed of in terms of the order dated 21.05.2025, with identical directions.
3. Placing reliance upon the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the issue involved in the present writ petition is identical to ***Dr. Sandeep Prajapat (supra)*** and other connected matters, decided by this Court vide order dated 21.05.2025, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition in terms of the aforesaid judgment.
4. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of with the same directions as issued in ***Dr. Sandeep Prajapat (supra)***, decided on 21.05.2025.

5. It is directed that the respondents shall examine whether the case of the petitioner is covered by the judgment relied upon and, if so, extend the benefit thereof in accordance with law; else, a reasoned and speaking order shall be passed, leaving it open for the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy in accordance with law. It is clarified that the present order has been passed solely on the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners.
