The present criminal misc. petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of BNSS for quashing of criminal proceedings arising out of FIR No. 56/2026 registered at Police Station Kareda, District Bhilwara for offences under Section 85, 79, 89, 115(2) and 352 of BNS, 2023.

Learned counsel for the parties contends that there is a possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties, as the dispute involved is matrimonial in nature. He submits that the details of respondent No.2, including the contact number, shall be provided before the Mediation Centre within a period of two days. Upon receipt of the same, the Registry shall issue notice to respondent No.2 and call upon her to appear in the mediation proceedings.

The matter is hereby referred to the Mediation Centre attached to this Hon'ble High Court.

The parties shall appear before the learned Mediator on 01.04.2026.

Let the matter be listed again before this Court on 22.04.2026 along with the Mediator's report.

The Office is directed to communicate this order to the Mediation Centre forthwith.
