The matter comes up for consideration of application (IA No.01/2026) seeking correction/modification in the order dated 23.03.2026 passed in S.B. Criminal Misc. Petition No.2239/2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in the present case, the Court has granted limited interim protection to

the petitioners so that the parties can participate in the mediation, but however, the same has been escaped from being recorded in the aforesaid order.

This Court has considered the aforesaid application and also checked the record. The Court had granted the interim order giving limited protection to the petitioners until the mediation proceedings are concluded, but however, the same could not be recorded in the aforesaid order inadvertently.

Hence, the aforesaid application is allowed.

Till the mediation proceedings are concluded, the petitioners shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.56/2026, Police Station Kareda, District Bhilwara.

However, it is made clear that this order of protection is only passed in order to make the mediation fruitful and if the mediation fails, the Court shall consider grant/extension of the interim order on merits.

The remaining part of the order 23.03.2026 shall remain intact.

This order would be treated as part and partial of the order dated 23.03.2026.

A copy of this order be sent to the Mediation Centre concerned forthwith.
