1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the bank account of the petitioner has been freezed on the basis of some Cyber complaint, discrepancies in the handling of the account and on the basis of certain doubtful entries.
3. Learned counsel further submits that to clarify those discrepancies in the account statement of the petitioner, the petitioner filed a fresh detailed representation before the Bank. He, therefore, prays that the respondent No. 2 & 3- Bank may be directed to decide the same at the earliest and defreeze the account of the petitioner.

4. In view of the above limited submissions made before this Court, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 & 3- IndusInd Bank, Phalodi to consider the representation to be submitted by the petitioner within one week and pass the appropriate orders for defreezing his bank account and if the same is not liable to be defreezed then the representation of the petitioner be decided by passing a speaking order. The petitioner shall file his reply/representation within a period of 15 days from today and the Bank shall decide the same within a period of 10 days thereafter.

5. Needless to say that the respondent-bank may ask for the requisite documents from the petitioner for satisfying the entries made in his bank account.

6. The stay application and other pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
