1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-petitioner. The petitioner has been arrested in connection with FIR No.09/2026 registered at Police Station Kuchera, District Nagaur for the offence(s) under Section 8/21 of NDPS Act.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the MDMA containing weight of 11.02 grams was recovered from Ram Prasad, apart from the disposal statement of co-accused, there is no substantive evidence available on record with regard to the supplying or transporting the aforesaid quantity. The petitioner is in custody since long and further trial/investigation of the case may take considerable time. There are no criminal antecedents with regard to the offences

under NDPS Act nor the petitioner, therefore, the bail application of the accused-petitioner may be allowed.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the recovery of contraband article containing weight of 11.02 grams MDMA was recovered from the co-accused Ram Prasad, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner-**Jagmal S/o Kanwarilal**, in connection with FIR No.09/2026 registered at Police Station Kuchera, District Nagaur shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
