By way of filing the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:

"In view of the facts and grounds stated above, it is respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to:

(a) Direct the respondent authorities to consider and decide the objections submitted by petitioner by passing a reasoned and speaking order;

(b) Restrain the respondents from giving final effect to the delimitation of Panchayat Samiti Siwana till objections are duly decided;

(c) Any other order which this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of petitioner."

2. After arguing the matter for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if the competent authority of the respondent - department is

directed to consider and decide the objections dated 07.01.2026 (Annex.2 & 3) submitted by the petitioner against the De-limitation of the Panchayat Samiti Siwana in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

3. In view of the aforesaid limited submission made at Bar by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the competent authority of the respondent – department to consider and decide the objections dated 07.01.2026 (Annex.2 & 3) submitted by the petitioner against the De-limitation of the Panchayat Samiti Sivana in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. It is made clear that the aforesaid direction to decide the objections has been issued only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of the petitioner's grievances and the same may not be construed to be an order to decide the representation in a particular manner.

5. Stay petition also stands disposed of.
