Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present case relates for running an institution at the rented premises of the complainant and providing space for the same which was vacated way back in the year 2019 however,the present FIR has been registered malafidely after a lapse of almost seven years claiming of the recovery of about Rs. 45,00,000/- which may at best be a cause of civil dispute.

In view of the same, this Court is inclined to interfere in the matter.

Issue notice.

Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.



Notice be issue to respondent No.2, returnable within four weeks.

Meanwhile, till the next date of hearing, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with the FIR No. 47/2025 registered at Police Station Gulabpura District Bhilwara. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation.
