1. The matter comes up on an application under Section 151 of C.P.C. (IA No.01/2026) seeking modification of the order dated 25.03.2026 passed by this Court.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent-claimant submits that pursuant to the order dated 25.03.2026, the appellant-insurance company had deposited 50% of the awarded amount (with interest) which has been kept in the fixed deposit. It is submitted that the claimant is still undergoing treatment and requires substantial funds for his future medical expenses and rehabilitation. Therefore, it is prayed that amount kept in fixed deposit be released to the claimant.
3. Learned counsel for the appellant has opposed the application.
4. Having considered the submissions made and taking into account the nature of injuries suffered by the claimant as well as his continuing medical needs, this Court is of the opinion that the

ends of justice would be met by permitting partial release of the deposited amount.

5. Accordingly, the application is partly allowed. It is directed that out of the 50% of the awarded amount deposited by the appellant-insurance company pursuant to the order dated 25.03.2026, 50% of the deposited amount shall be released in favour of respondent-claimant by transferring the same to his savings bank account, after due verification of his identity and bank account particulars by the Tribunal.

6. The balance 50% of the deposited amount shall continue to remain invested in fixed deposit(s) on the same terms and conditions as contained in the order dated 08.04.2026 and shall abide by the final outcome of the appeal.

7. It is made clear that, if the appeal is decided against the claimants, the amount so deposited in favour of the respondent-claimant shall be returned by the claimants to the appellant-Insurance Company with interest.

8. The application stands disposed of.
