1. By way of the present writ petition has been filed by the
petitioner's seeking the following reliefs:-

*"In view of the facts and grounds stated above, the
humble petitioner most respectfully prays that this
Hon'ble Court may be pleased to:*

*i. Quash and set aside the advertisement dated (4)
28.11.2025 issued by the District Supply Officer, Udaipur
insofar as it relates to the Fair Price Shop of Gram
Panchayat Bansda (FPS Code 4759).*

*ii. Direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's
application for compassionate allotment of the said Fair
Price Shop.*

*iii. Direct the respondents to issue authorization of the
said Fair Price Shop in favour of the petitioner.*

*iv. Restrain the respondents from allotting the said Fair
Price Shop to any third party.*

*V. Pass any other order or direction which this Hon'ble
Court may deem just and proper.*

vi. Award costs of the writ petition to the petitioner, in the interest of justice."

2. After arguing the matter for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if the competent authority of the respondents is directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner's seeking compassionate appointment of fair price shop (FPS Code 4759) situated in Gram Panchayat Bansda in his favour in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

3. In view of the aforesaid submission made at Bar by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to file a fresh representation ventilating his grievances alongwith a certified copy of the order instant within a period of two weeks from today before the District Supply Officer, Udaipur.

4. In case, a representation is so filed, the competent authority of the respondent shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two weeks from receipt thereof.

5. It is made clear that aforesaid direction to decide the representation has been issued only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of petitioner's grievances and the same may not be construed to be an order to decide the representation in a particular manner.

6. Stay petition as well as all pending application, if any, stand disposed of.
