The matter comes up on application (IA No.1/26) for modification of order.

Application allowed.

The present criminal misc. application filed by the petitioner for correction in order dated 12.03.2026 passed by this Court in S.B. Criminal misc. petition No.1661/2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case bail bonds of the petitioner had already been accepted, and this Court had passed an interim order that the final report may not be filed, but however due to inadvertence the stay on arrest came to be recorded.

This Court has verified the record.

In view of the same, this Court is inclined to accept the application. It seems that order regarding arrest came to be wrongly recorded. The last para of order dated 12.03.2026 will now read as under-

“In the meanwhile, no result will be filed by the investigating officer in connection with FIR No.66/2020, registered at Police Station Bhadra, District Hanumangarh till the next date of hearing.”

This order shall be treated as part and parcel of the order dated 12.03.2026.
