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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE MUKESH RAJPUROHIT**

**Order**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had instituted a suit for recovery of possession and permanent injunction. It is submitted that, as the Patta was not in the possession of the petitioner, an application under Order XI Rule 12 of CPC was preferred for summoning the entire record, including the Patta, from the Gram Panchayat, however, the same came to be rejected.

It is submitted that the Patta in question pertains to suit property and is necessary to bring on record for just decision of the suit

Learned counsel further submits that in the absence of the Patta being brought on record, the very purpose of instituting the suit for recovery of possession and permanent injunction would stand frustrated.

The matter requires consideration.

Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.

In the meanwhile and till next date, further proceedings in Civil Suit No.09/2016, pending before Civil Judge, Jahajpur, District Bhilwara shall remain stayed.
