1. Learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that in identical matter being *S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.3286/2019 (Ramprakash Roj Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.)*, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 06.03.2019 has granted interim order, while issuing notices.

2. In view of the submissions made, issue notice to the respondents. Issue notice of stay application also, returnable within four weeks.
3. Meanwhile, the respondent-authorities are directed to relieve the petitioner from the post of Sub-Inspector to join on the post of R.A.S. without insisting for payment of refund of training expense/salary. However, the said relieving of the petitioner shall remain subject to the final outcome of the present writ petition.
4. The concerned authority shall relieve the petitioner within a period of two days of placing a certified copy of the order instant, whereafter new appointing authority will allow the petitioner to join on the post of R.A.S., if he reports within a period of ten days from the date of relieving.
