1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, without affording any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner-firm, the respondent-Superintending Engineer, Public Health Engineering Department, Circle Didwana-Kuchaman, vide office order dated 05.02.2026, has cancelled the work order dated 02.04.2025

issued in its favour. It is further submitted that the EMD of Rs. 60,000/- has been forfeited and the petitioner-firm has been debarred from participating in any tender process floated by the Circle Office, PHED, or its Divisional Offices.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that it is a settled principle of law that no order having civil or adverse consequences against the petitioner-firm can be passed without affording it an opportunity of hearing.

3. The matter requires consideration.

4. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application as well.

5. In the meantime, and until next date of hearing, Clauses 2 and 3 of the office order dated 05.02.2026, passed by the Superintending Engineer, PHED, Circle Didwana-Kuchaman, shall remain stayed.

6. It is made clear that, if the petitioner participates in any tender floated by the Circle Office, Didwana-Kuchaman, or its subordinate Divisional Offices, such participation shall remain subject to the final outcome of the present writ petition.
