Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant and petitioner were business partners in relation to some investment works. However, subsequently a dispute arose between them pursuant to which the complaint was filed by the complainant at Police Station Sadar, District Sriganganagar.

It is further submitted that no case found against the petitioner in the said complaint. However, in order to falsely implicate the petitioner on the basis of false and concocted story, the present FIR has been lodged. It is contended that the petitioner was thoroughly interrogated in connection to the said complaint and the police authorities have refused to provide a

copy of the complaint. An application for the same in the RTI was filed and a letter dated 08.10.2025 was also produced and therefore, he is unable to produce the same.

In view of the above, it seems that the present proceedings has been instituted maliciously and this Court is inclined to interfere in the matter.

Issue notice.

Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Notice be issued to respondent No.2, returnable within four weeks.

Meanwhile, till the next date of hearing, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with the FIR No.519/2025 registered at Police Station Sadar, District Sriganganagar. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation.
