1. The instant misc. interim bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-applicant **Nahar Singh @ Prakash S/o Jethu Singh** for releasing on interim bail on the ground of death of his brother on 18.3.2026. The applicant has been arrested in connection with **FIR No.25/2024** registered at **Police Station Asind District Bhilwara** for the offence **under Sections 506, 384, 363, 344, 376(2)(n) and 376(3) of IPC and Sections 3/4(2), 5(L)/6 of POCSO Act.**

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that it is necessary to attend the last rituals of his brother, thus the applicant deserves to be granted the interim bail.
3. Learned public prosecutor opposed the interim bail application. He submitted the report dated 26.3.2026 from the SHO, Bijayanagar District Beawar regarding the death of applicant's brother which is taken on record.
4. Looking to the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, a humanitarian approach is required to be adopted, thus, this Court deems it just and proper to grant interim bail to the present accused-applicant for a period of seven days from the date of his release.
5. Accordingly, the interim bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-applicant named above shall be enlarged on interim bail for a period of seven days from the date of release provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
6. After seven days from the date of release of the applicant, he shall surrender himself before the Superintendent of the concerned Jail.
7. List this matter on 07.04.2026 to see whether the accused applicant has surrendered after availing the interim bail or not.
