The instant interim bail application under Section 483 of BNSS has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Gajendra Singh, who is in custody in connection with FIR No.341/2025 registered at Police Station Devgarh, District Rajsmand for offences under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 103(1), 109(1), 118(1)(2), 190, 191(2) (3) of BNS and Section 4/25 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's father Sohan Singh died accidentally on 16.03.2026. The petitioner has submitted the supporting documents along with the FIR in which it is shown that the petitioner's father has died due to accident.

Learned Public Prosecutor does not controvert the said fact and the fact mentioned in the FIR.

Considering the fact that the interim bail application of the petitioner is allowed for 15 days' to participate in the rituals of his late father.

Accordingly, it is hereby directed that the petitioner- **Gajendra Singh S/o Sohan Singh Rawat**, shall be enlarged on interim bail for a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and two sureties in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court. Needless to say that after availing interim bail, the petitioner shall surrender before the concerned jail authority in the evening of 14.04.2026.

The concerned jail authorities and the trial court are directed to sent report to this Court regarding surrender of the petitioner.

In case the petitioner fails to surrender before the Jail Authorities within stipulated time, his bail bonds shall be forfeited and the proceedings for arresting the petitioner shall be initiated immediately by the trial court.
