1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allotment case of the petitioner in the category of Pong Dam Oustee is pending consideration before the respondent No.3- Allotment Officer cum Additional Commissioner Colonization (Appeal/rehabilitation) Bikaner, District Bikaner (Raj.) and the same has not been decided till date. He, therefore, prays that the respondent No.3 may be directed to decide the pending application for grant of allotment to the petitioner at the earliest.

3. Considering the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3- Allotment Officer cum Additional Commissioner Colonization (Appeal/rehabilitation) Bikaner, District Bikaner (Raj.) to decide the allotment case of the petitioner in the category of Pong Dam Oustee at the earliest, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, strictly in accordance with law.

4. The stay application as well as other pending misc. applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
