The present criminal miscellaneous petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of the BNSS for quashing of FIR No. 18/2026, registered at Police Station Jayal, District Nagaur, for the offences under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 324(2), and 303(2) of the BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had earlier registered FIR No. 0119/2025 dated 11.09.2025 regarding an incident dated 10.09.2025, wherein the complainant, Mohanlal, had entered their fields and caused injuries to them. He further submits that, with mala fide intention, the said Mohanlal—who is an accused in that case—has now registered the present FIR for the same incident.

This Court has perused both the FIRs. The incident alleged pertains to 10.09.2025, whereas the present FIR has been registered subsequently on 20.01.2026.

In view of the above, this Court is inclined to interfere in the matter.

Issue notice.

Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Let notice be issued to respondent No. 2, returnable within four weeks.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No. 18/2026, registered at Police Station Jayal, District Nagaur; however, he shall join the investigation.
