It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that an eviction petition was preferred by the respondent against the petitioner in respect to a shop and during pendency of the petition, the petitioner preferred an application under Order VIII 1(3) read with Section 151 of CPC and Section 21 of the Act of 2001 for taking certain documents and photographs on record but the same was rejected.
2. Learned counsel contended that the petitioner is having a right of defence in all possible measures and while submitting certain photographs/documents, the petitioner has to prove his defence.
3. The matter requires consideration.

4. Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.

5. In the meanwhile and till next date, further proceedings in Civil Suit No.69/2020 pending before the learned Senior Civil Judge-Cum-Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate (Rent Tribunal), Udaipur shall remain stayed.
