The present criminal miscellaneous petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of the BNSS for quashing of FIR No. 24/2026 registered at Police Station Bhinder, District Udaipur, for offences under Section 3/7 of the Essential Commodities Act and Section 287 of the BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner owns a tanker with a capacity of 2000 liters and is using the same for supplying diesel/petrol for the use of agriculturists. It is further submitted that, as per the Petroleum Products (Maintenance of Production, Storage and Supply) Order, 1999, he is permitted to possess petroleum products up to 2500 liters.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the judgment passed by this Hon'ble Court in ***Karamjeet Singh vs. State of Rajasthan in CRLRP No. 1361/2014***, wherein similar proceedings were quashed by this Court.

In view of the above, this Court is inclined to interfere in the matter.

Issue notice.

Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Let notice be issued to respondent No. 2, returnable within four weeks.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No. 24/2026 registered at Police Station Bhinder, District Udaipur; however, he shall join the investigation.
