Counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already executed power of attorney in favour of his son and he never drove the vehicle. He further submits that he is driver of heavy vehicle and has no connection with the offence. He further submits that the I.O. is not taking into consideration the power of attorney executed in favour of accused Lokesh.

After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press this misc. petition on merits, however, seeks liberty to file a detailed representation before the I.O.

The liberty sought for is granted.

However, if any such representation is filed by the petitioner, it is expected that the Investigating Officer shall consider the same objectively strictly in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the criminal misc. petition is dismissed as not pressed with the aforesaid liberty.

Stay application and all pending applications, if any, stands disposed of accordingly.
