By way of filing the present writ petition, the petitioner has
prayed for the following reliefs:-

*"It is, therefore most humbly and respectfully prayed
that in the light of the above mentioned facts and
circumstances, it is therefore most respectfully and humbly
prayed that by an appropriate writ order or direction:-*

*A. The act of the respondent by which they have freezed the
bank account no. 422261146623 IFSC CODE SBIN0004301
OF THE PETITIONER AT SBI BRACH DEFENCE LAB JODHPUR
DISTRICT JODHPUR petitioner May be quashed and set aside
and respondent Bank may be directed to defreeze the bank
account of the petitioner and permit him to operate the bank
account.*

*B. Any other appropriate order or direction which this Hon'ble
Court deems just and proper in the peculiar facts and
circumstances of this case may be passed in favour of the
petitioners."*

2. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, this Court *prima facie* finds that the respondent-Bank, acting under the instructions of the police authorities on account of an alleged suspicious transaction of Rs. 59,000/- in the petitioner's bank account maintained with the State Bank of India (Account No. 422261146623), has frozen the said account.

3. In the opinion of this Court, it would be highly improper and unjust to continue the freezing of the petitioner's bank account and restrain him from carrying out transactions, particularly when, *prima facie*, he does not appear to be a suspect in the criminal case registered by the police.

4. In that view of the matter, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-Bank to defreeze the petitioner's bank account bearing No. 422261146623 and permit him to carry out normal banking transactions. However, the respondents shall keep the disputed amount of Rs. 59,000/- under lien; in other words, the petitioner shall maintain a minimum balance of Rs. 59,000/- in the said account till the conclusion of the investigation by the police or until further instructions are issued by the police for release of the aforesaid amount.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition as well as the stay petition stand disposed of.
