1. By way of the present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners' seeking the following reliefs:-

"It is, therefore, most humbly and respectfully prayed that the writ petition may kindly be allowed and by issuing an appropriate writ, order or direction:-

i. The respondents may kindly be directed to delete the names of the petitioners from the electoral roll of Gram Panchayat Igyasani and include their names in the

electoral roll of Gram Panchayat Rajod, District Nagaur, in accordance with law.

ii. The respondents may kindly be directed to rectify and correct the electoral roll so as to enable the petitioners to exercise their statutory right to vote in Gram Panchayat Rajod.

Iii. Any other appropriate relief which this Hon'ble High Court deems just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioners."

2. After arguing the matter for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners would be satisfied if the competent authority of the respondents is directed to consider and decide their case regarding the deletion of their names from the Electoral Roll of Gram Panchayat Igyasani and the inclusion of their names in the Electoral Roll of Gram Panchayat Rajod, District Nagaur in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

3. In view of the aforesaid submission made at Bar by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to file a fresh representation ventilating their grievances alongwith a certified copy of the order instant within a period of three days from today before the competent authority of the respondent department.

4. In case, a representation is so filed, the competent authority of the respondents shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 15 days from receipt thereof.

5. It is made clear that aforesaid direction to decide the representation has been issued only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of petitioners' grievances and the same may not be construed to be an order to decide the representation in a particular manner.



6. Stay petition as well as all pending application, if any, stand disposed of.
