By way of filing the instant writ petition, the petitioner has been challenge to the charge sheet (Annexure 3) dated 17.12.2024 which speaks about enquiry against the three persons, one Jitendra Kumar Jain (the petitioner herein), RPS the then Circle Officer Circle Nagar, (west) Udaipur, Sunil Kumar Tailor Police Inspector, the then SHO P.S. Ambamata and Narayan Singh, Head Constable P.S. Sukher. Learned counsel shown to this Court a copy of an interim order dated 17.02.2025 passed by a coordinate bench of this Court in which the operation of memo of charges dated 17.12.2024 to the extent of Sunil Kumar Tailor has been stayed. Learned counsel also drew the attention of the Court

towards the recommendation dated 27.06.2025 made by the high level committee making a recommendation for dropping the enquiry against the petitioner. It is the grievance of the petitioner that despite recommendation of the high level committee on 27.06.2025 to stop the proceeding against the petitioner, nothing has been done till now. It is further argued that the undue procrastination has been made just to debar the petitioner from taking his matter for promotion purpose.

2. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable after four weeks.
3. In the meanwhile, further proceeding in connection with charge-sheet (Annexure-3) dated 17.12.2024 issued by Joint Secretary shall remain stayed qua the petitioner.
