HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE FARJAND ALI**Order****28/03/2026**

1. At the very outset, it is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the issue raised in the present writ petition is covered by an order dated 20.01.2014 passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court at Jaipur in the case of **Yogesh Kumar Pareek Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors. : S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 3534/2009**. He submits that the petitioners may be permitted to file representation qua the grievance raised in the present writ petition and the respondents may be directed to decide the same within a reasonable time.
2. In view of the aforesaid submissions, without commenting on merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioners to file a representation, which shall be gone into by the competent authority and decide the same, in accordance with law, keeping in view the observations made in the case of Yogesh Kumar Pareek (supra), as expeditiously as possible.
