This criminal misc. petition under Section 528 BNSS has been preferred on behalf of the petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No.78/2026 registered at Police Station Sanchor, District Jalore for offences under Section 318(4) and 316(2) BNS.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is only the purchaser of the vehicle and the allegations are against the seller accused-Nawab Khan who has sold the vehicle but however, petitioner is being falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that there are three consecutive agreements which have been executed between the parties.

Hence, in light of the same, averments made in the FIR cannot sustain as the Investigating Officer has failed to consider

the prior three agreements. It is thus prayed that the petitioners be permitted to file a representation and place all the relevant documents before Investigating Officer who shall be directed to investigate in the matter fairly.

Accordingly, the instant criminal misc. petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to submit a detailed representation to the concerned Investigating Officer averring therein all the grounds which have been raised in this petition within a period of 07 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

In the even, representation is submitted, the concerned Investigating Officer is directed to minutely and objectively consider the contents of the same. All the relevant documents with the representation shall also be taken into consideration.

Till 15 days from the date of filing of representation, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.78/2026 registered at Police Station Sanchor, District Jalore.

All pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
