1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-petitioner. The petitioner has been arrested in connection with FIR No.28/2026 registered at Police Station Sadas, District Chittorgarh for the offence(s) under Section 8/18 of NDPS Act.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further contended that the alleged quantity of recovered contraband article, i.e. opium is 02.29 kg, which is below the commercial quantity and there are no criminal antecedents against the petitioner. The petitioner is behind the bars since long and further trial of the case may take considerable time to conclude, therefore, the bail application of the petitioner may kindly be allowed.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.
4. Heard and perused the material available on record.
5. Considering the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner and looking to the fact that the recovered contraband article is below commercial quantity; there are no criminal antecedents against the petitioner; the accused-petitioner is behind the bars since long and the trial of the case may take considerable time, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Shankar Lal S/o Haluram Gurjar**, in connection with FIR No.28/2026 registered at Police Station Sadas, District Chittorgarh shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
